Headworks Contributions for Temporary Developments

Busselton Water will allow the provision of a temporary connection to the scheme where it can be shown that the purpose of the connection is clearly of a short term, specific nature.

Examples include a service to: a construction camp; a fixed standpipe; establish vegetation in a new subdivision's entry street or a median strip.

A temporary service can only be provided where there is a capacity in the scheme to support the additional demand.

There are two categories of a temporary connection;

1. A water service required for less than two years for the establishment of vegetation;
2. A water service required for less than one year; for dust suppression, earth works or road works.

The application is responsible for payment of:

- Consumption charges;
- Connection and disconnection fees; and
- Loss or damage to the water meter or water service.

All assessed charges must be paid prior to connection.
